

Atlantic Coast Child Welfare Implementation Center Sample Logic Model

Problem statement. *Sample* child welfare agency has not been in substantial compliance with Permanency 1, Component A: Timeliness or Component B Permanency of Reunification. Assumption: Birth families are not successfully engaged to change the behaviors and conditions that led to the need for placement which leads to children staying in care beyond 12 months and coming back into care following reunification.

Implementation Project Goals. To improve the implementation of family centered practice beginning immediately upon placement to ultimately improve the timeliness of reunification within 12 months and reduce the likelihood of re-entry into care.
